

Article 1. General clauses

Goals: to give musicians the opportunity to express themselves musically by leaving the traditional styles aside, and to offer the public a different face of the alphorn. **The competition takes place on the Saturday evening in the festival tent.**

Article 2. Participants

As the competition lasts one hour, the number of participants (solos or groups) is limited to 10 performances. The participants will be chosen on a first come first served basis. A musician can perform only once in the FUN competition, so that as many musicians as possible can take part. However, these musicians can also participate in the official competition.

Article 3. Instruments

The participants can play the instrument of their choice: alphorn, büchel, wood or carbon, two tones or more (ensemble), association of instruments.

Article 4. Performances

The performance must last for a maximum of 5 minutes. All styles of music can be interpreted, with or without accompaniment; in the case of accompaniment, the putting in place must be done quickly. The performance can be animated with a visual element (light show, film), according to the participants' wishes and imagination. The dress code is free.

Article 5. Jury, prizes

A jury, who are not at all part of the alphorn world, will designate a « coup de cœur » prize to the performance of their choice, taking into account firstly of the musical quality, but also of the show, the scenic presence, the contact with the public, the originality, etc. No other places will be classed and no other prizes given. **The winner will be announced during the evening.**

Article 6. Final

The winner of the FUN competition will perform on the Sunday at the beginning of the official competition final.
